

HEIDELBERG PARISH MARRIAGES 1839, 1840

Twenty-Five Roman Catholic Church marriages were recorded in Heidelberg Parish Church in the year 1839, and 30 marriages were found for the year 1840. The notes following indicate households where the family names from these records could be found in the various Prischib / Molotschna colonies, as listed by Dr. Karl Stumpp in the 1811 censuses for these village-colonies.
