[Translator's Note: The following information is taken from a file folder of DAI (Deutsches Ausland-Institut) documents captured in Germany during World War II which contains documents dealing with ethnic Germans from Russia between 1940 and 1941. As ethnic Germans from the East were brought to Germany, they stayed in transit camps, awaiting assignment to where they would be sent to live. This document lists the names of 54 Bessarabian German heads of households and the camps where they waited in transit.]
