[Translator's Notes: In order for people to be allowed to participate in the 1940 Resettlement movement out of Bessarabia, every man, woman and child had to have a number assigned to them upon registration. Without the number, a person was not to be allowed to board any mode of transport taking re-settlers out of Bessarabia. The following is a list of numbers issued to the Kischinev Regional District in Bessarabia. Evidently, there were some questions as to whether some people of mixed marriages should be granted a registration number and this list reflects that. It should be noted that "mixed marriage" did not mean a marriage between black, white, brown, yellow, etc., but between a German and a non-German. Listed are the names of those people of mixed marriage who participated in the Ki-1 portion of the Kischinev transportation evacuation, their ethnic heritage, what their religious affiliation was, and other remarks. This document is a carbon copy of the original and the carbon has smeared in places so that it is difficult to determine exactly what some of the typed characters are. Best guess was made to identify those letters.]
